April Message From Pastor Tim

The Greatest Moment in History

April is upon us, and many historical events took place in April. Since Easter falls on April 17, let us focus on events from that day through history.

In 1961 1500 Cuban exiles invaded the Bay of Pigs in Cuba to overthrow Fidel Castor. In 1964 Ford introduced the Mustang.

1969—Presidential candidate Robert Kennedy's killer, Sirhan Sirhan, was found guilty of first-degree murder. In 1970 Apollo 13 lost the number 2 Oxygen tank while on its way to the moon. There are many other noteworthy events occurring on April 17 throughout history.

This year we celebrate Easter on April 17. Just like each of the events listed above impacted and represented a part of our history as humans, Easter celebrates the most important historical event to impact our lives regardless of whether we believe or not.

As Christians, we celebrate life over death. At the fall in the time of Adam and Eve, death resulted as a consequence of sin. God never wanted that for us, but instead wanted life and relationship with Him forever. But sin entered, and now we who are sinful, could no longer have the relationship with the one who is sinless. God yearned for that relationship and chose a way to bridge that divide between us. He sent His one and only Son Jesus Christ to pay the price for our sin.

Easter culminates that victory over death. By the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, Satan no longer holds the power and authority over our living or dying. Through our faith in Jesus as Lord and Savior we experience resurrection of our lives to be with God forever.

When I came to Christ and gave my life to Him, Easter became the most significant and important historical event for me. Despite my sinful nature and history of going after the things of this world, God forgave me and welcomed me back into His goodness and mercy.

I pray you find that same satisfying peace and love this Easter. Come and celebrate with us all week long. Join us as we watch Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Gather with us as we partake the cup and the bread on Jesus' last night with us. Feel the depth of despair on Good Friday as we watch them nail Jesus to the cross. And celebrate with us on Easter Sunday Jesus' resurrection from the dead. Come be part of the greatest moment in human history, that changed the world forever.







The Nehemiah Code




