June Message From Pastor Tim

But The Time Has Come

How many of you have stood at an airport and watched a loved one enter that airport knowing it would be a long time before you see them again? Some of you have taken your children off to college and had that moment when your emotions flood over you because your child is grown, and, despite all the frustrations of raising a child, you will miss them terribly. How many of you stood on your porch, and watched as a military car pulls up to your front door, and escorts your child to the nearest indoctrination center to begin their basic training?

For the third time in my life I write a letter to say goodbye. I sit at my desk and type these words, and clearly understand the feelings you had watching a loved one leave. None of these letters came easily, and none of them brought comfort to me. Perhaps that means my time with each of these communities of faith meant more than I realized. But the time has come for me to minister in a different community, and offer my gifts to that community of faith. And now the time comes for another to arrive here and offer his talents and gifts to this community of faith.

In Acts 20:13-38, Paul tells the Ephesian Church good-bye. In verse 25 Paul tells the church "Now I know that none among whom I have gone about preaching the kingdom will ever see me again." He is headed to Jerusalem and will not be able to return to Ephesus. But Paul offers these words of encouragement and I echo them as well; "Now I commit you to God and to the word of his grace, which can build you up and give you an inheritance among all those who are sanctified." (Acts 20:32). No pastor, no Bishop, no lay person can offer sanctification. Only God provides the sanctifying power through the Holy Spirit. And we receive the Holy Spirit through our faith in Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. So as Paul offered God and grace to the Ephesians, and I offer God and grace to you.

I promise to remember you always with great joy and fondness. First UMC provides a great opportunity for others to come to know Jesus Christ. St Marys, despite the silliness of the Diamond, feels like home and offers so much for every person to enjoy and be a productive member of society. Hold onto your values, and hold especially to the Word of God in your hearts. If you do, you will persevere, endure, and overcome any obstacles Satan puts in your way.

We love you, and will never forget you. Thank you for nine amazing years serving you and this community.



Lee Appointed to St. Marys UMC Announced: 04-17-2022



About Sang Hak Lee

Sang Hak Lee was born and raised in Seoul, South Korea in a devoted Christian household. He learned how to serve God and His church through observing his grandfather, who planted several churches in Korea in the early 20th Century, and his father, who planted a church in Seoul after the Korean War. He adopted his family's multigenerational calling to extend God's Kingdom and take care of His people.



Sang Hak earned his Bachelor's in Theology at HyupSung University. He has a Master of Theology degree from the Korean Methodist Theological Seminary and a Master of Divinity degree from KangNam University in Korea. He has studied at the Asbury Theological Seminary in Wilmore, Kentucky for his doctorate. Sang Hak Lee was originally ordained in Korea and has since served in churches around Korea and the United States as a minister and pastor. He has served in Korea in Seoul (a Megacity), Suji (a suburban area), Uljin (a Fishing Village), and Moongyeong (a Mountain village). In the U.S. he has served in various towns in Kansas. He has planted two churches in Uljin and Moongyeong, among other places in Korea.

Sang Hak served as the president of Cozy Mind, an organization that supports children and senior citizens who live alone in Korea. He was the pastor of the Christian High Schools' Union, the representative of a Counseling Clinic, and a Camp Director for a college students' summer retreat camp of the Korean Methodist Church.

Sang Hak Lee is a licensed Sexual Violence Counselor and Domestic Violence Counselor by the Ministry of Gender Equality & Family Republic of Korea. He was fully trained for the overseas mission hosted by the Korean Methodist Church in Seoul, Korea.

At the Great Plains Conference in Kansas and Nebraska, Sang Hak was a member of the Connecting Council and the Convener of the Mission Alignment Team. He also acted as a member of DCOM and was a Network leader in the Salina District.

Sang Hak's passion is for ministry and aspires to extend God's Kingdom on Earth and to make and support disciples of Jesus Christ. His spiritual gifts for ministry are preaching, pastoral care, and building up discipleship programs.

He is married to Jong Youn Lee and they have two daughters: Ye Joo and Ye Gang Lee. Ye Joo is a law student at Columbia Law School in New York City, and Ye Gang is a freshman at the University of Kansas in Lawrence, KS.


