



#### Irresistible, Reclaiming the New that Jesus Unleashed For the World

Once upon a time there was a version of our faith that was practically . . . irresistible. What did first-century Christians know that we don't? In this six-session study, Andy Stanley will invite you to embrace the version of faith that, against all odds, initiated a chain of events resulting in the most significant and extensive cultural transformation the world has ever seen. A version we must embrace if we are to be salt and light in an increasingly savorless and dark world. Two thousand years ago, Christians risked persecution and death for the sake of their faith. What would happen if 21st-century believers followed their lead? Taking you back to a time when Christianity couldn't be ignored, marginalized, or eradicated, Stanley shows how the early church turned the world upside down---and how we can recover that same faith.

Andy helps us consider the faith modeled by our first-century brothers and sisters who had no official Bible, and little chance of survival. What made their faith so irresistible? Andy will invite you to embrace the faith that caused the most significant cultural transformation the world has ever seen and how Jesus's arrival signaled that the Old Testament was fulfilled and its laws reduced to a single verb - **love** - to be applied to God, neighbor, and enemy.
